

HOT JOBS!

in Greenville

The Greenville Local Workforce Development Area (LWDA) is expected to add more than 37,600 jobs between 2012 and 2022, according to employment projections by the SC Department of Employment and Workforce's Business Intelligence Department. That is a projected rate of 14.9 percent over the ten-year period.

Based on the results of this forecast, "Hot Jobs" have been identified as in-demand for this time period. This list is helpful to educators, career counselors, students, and others making career plans.

- Accountants and auditors
- Civil engineers
- Computer systems analysts
- Computer user support specialists
- Elementary school teachers, except special education
- First-line supervisors of construction trades and extraction
- First-line supervisors of office and administrative support
- General and operations managers
- Healthcare social workers
- Industrial machinery mechanics
- Management analysts
- Market research analysts and marketing specialists
- Medical and health services managers
- Real estate sales agents
- Registered nurses
- Sales representatives, services, all other
- Software developers, applications
- Training and development specialists

All of these occupations meet three specific criteria:

- A projected growth rate of at least 14.9 percent over the ten years,
- An increase of at least 150 jobs, and
- An average annual salary of at least \$42,315 (the 2015 average for all jobs in the LWDA).

The most in-demand job will likely be Registered Nurses (+1,467) and the highest salary will be for General and Operational Managers at \$101,427 per year.

The data for these projections was compiled using standard statistical models funded by the U.S. Department of Labor. The projections were reviewed and revised by economic experts in South Carolina prior to publication.
