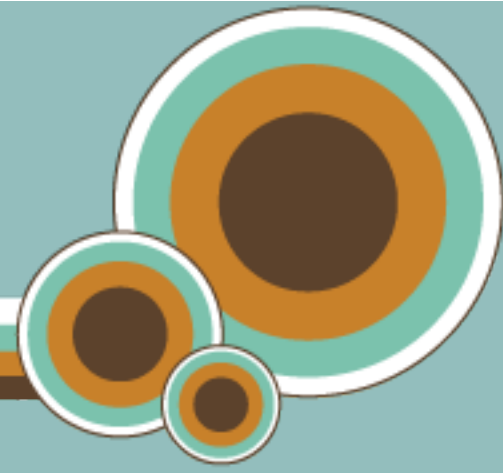
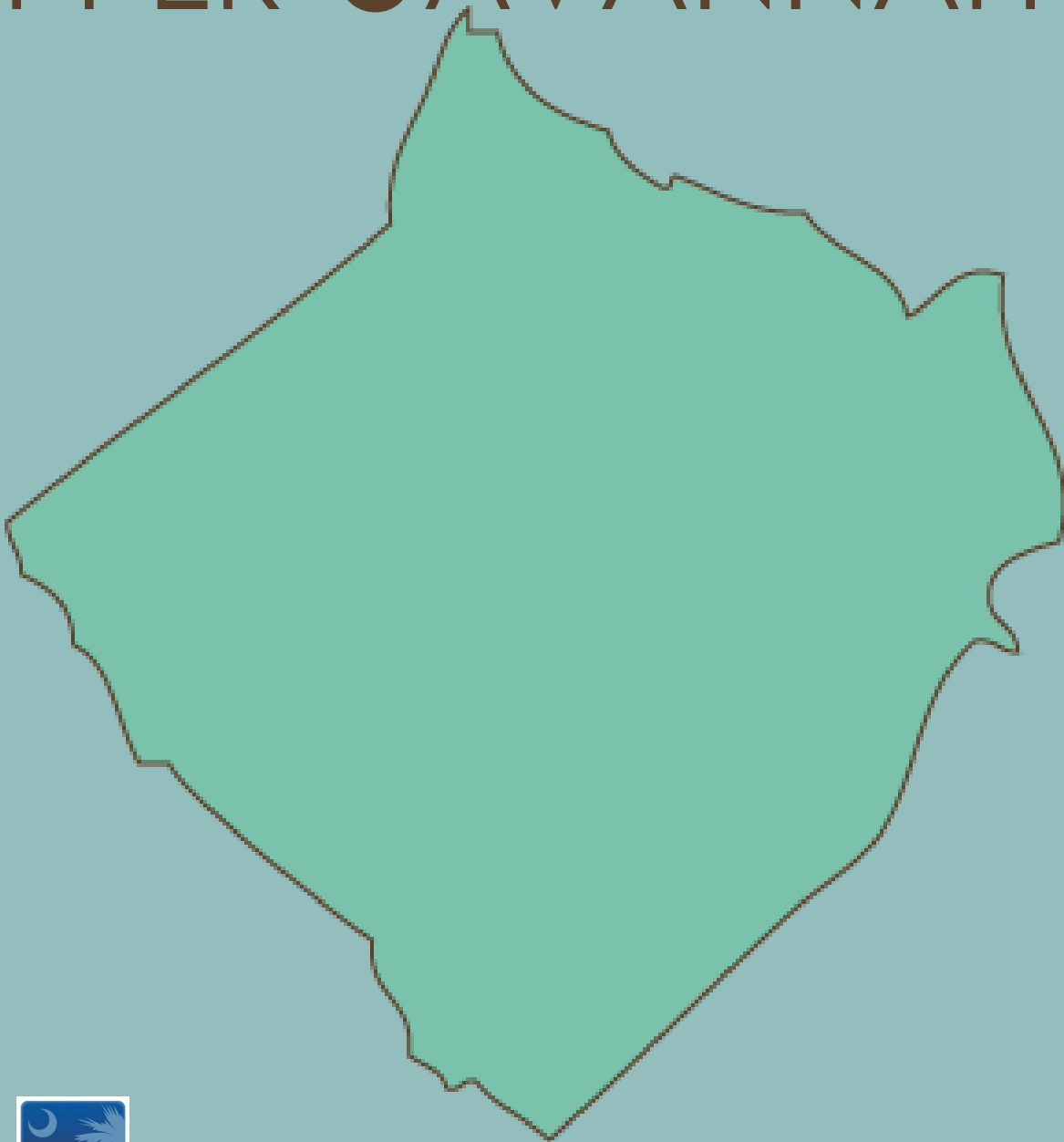

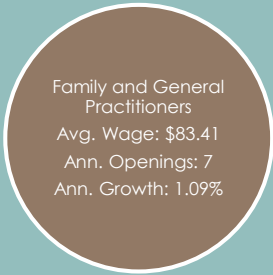

► Occupations requiring more education and training typically compensate workers with higher wages.



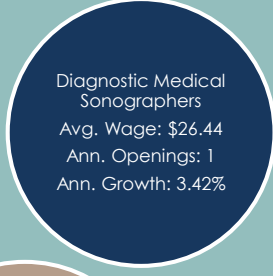
